	the OCC including giving up my right to appeal and to have my appeal heard before an impartial	
	judge of the Office of Administrative Hearings.	
4.	I understand that the OCC may notify parents of children in my care or anyone else deemed	
	appropriate by the OCC that the Letter of Compliance facility is no longer licensed.	
5.	I understand if I continue to provide child care services without a Letter of Compliance	
	certificate, then I may be fined for operating a Letter of Compliance facility without a certificate.	
6.	I have read the information contained herein or have had it read to me and I understand it. I	
	have also initialed each statement indicating that I understand and agree with each statement.	
7.	I still want to voluntarily surrender the Letter of Compliance Certificate. I am no longer going to	
	provide child care services in the State of Maryland without first re-applying to the OCC and	
	being approved by the OCC for the issuance of a new Letter of Compliance certificate. I also	
	agree to voluntarily forfeit any appeal rights I may have in this matter.
