WHY THERE IS A CRUCIAL NEED FOR DIAPERS:

- 5.2 million children in the U.S. aged 3 or younger live in poor or low-income families
- Infants require up to 10 diapers per day, costing families between \$70-\$80 per month, per baby
- Diapers cannot be purchased with food stamps
- Some families cut back on basics such as food, utilities, or child care to purchase diapers, while others need to leave their infants in soiled diapers for a longer period of time, leading to potential health risks
- Childcare programs require parents to provide enough diapers per day; if a parent cannot afford them, they cannot leave their child in daycare to attend work or school
