FAMILY CHILD CARE PROVIDER DIRECT GRANT FUND PROGRAM



Do you need assistance achieving or maintaining compliance with the requirements of the Office of Child Care, Licensing in Maryland?



Overview

The Family Child Care Provider Direct Grant Fund Program provides reimbursements to registered family child care providers for expenses incurred to comply with the Office of Child Care licensing requirements.

- The applicant must acquire compliance related expenses.
- Applicants are eligible for a <u>one-time</u> award.





Applicants must meet the following requirements to receive funds:

- 1. A registered family child care provider serving at least one child.
- 2. Combined annual family income must not exceed 60 percent of the State median income (SMI) for the applicant's family size.

The Provider Grant is regulated by State statute in COMAR 13A.14.07.

Grant Awards

- Family care providers serving at least one child may be awarded a grant of up to \$500.
- Grants awards are based on funding availability.
