
Maryland EXCELS is the Maryland State Department of Education's Quality Rating and Improvement System (QRIS) for child care, Head Start, school-age programs, and public Pre-K.

Our mission is to increase access to high-quality care and education across the state and to educate families on choosing quality programs.

I ELIGIBILITY

All licensed Child Care Centers (including school-age only, Letter of Compliance and Head Start programs) and registered Family Child Care Homes are eligible to participate in Maryland EXCELS.

Licensed child care programs are **required** to participate in Maryland EXCELS in order to be eligible for Child Care Scholarship reimbursement.

I ROAD TO QUALITY RATINGS





Quality Rating 1

- Activities support every child's individual needs.
- Family-teacher conferences are offered.





Quality Rating 4

- Community resources are used and shared with families.
- Continuous engagement with families is offered.
- Activities align with a state-recommended curriculum.
- Children have input in shaping rules and choosing activities.





Quality Rating 2

- Children's developmental progress is observed.
- Activities are informed by early learning guidelines.
- Opportunities are offered for families to engage in the program.





Quality Rating 5

- Lesson plans and policies are culturally competent.
- Children's developmental growth is consistently observed and assessed.
- Programs demonstrates excellence in quality improvement through accreditation.
- Provider and/or staff are highly qualified through education and experience.





Quality Rating 3

- Materials reflect the children's cultures and interests.
- Activities support exploring and developmental growth.
- Healthy meals and snacks are provided.



As funds are available, programs receive bonuses for increasing their quality ratings.

IEXCELS PAYMENTS

At Quality Ratings 3, 4, and 5, programs receive increased Child Care Scholarship reimbursements of 10-44%.
